ORDER

THIS MATTER came before the Court on the 15th day of January, 2003 on the Guardian ad Litem's Request for Status Conference. Petitioner's counsel, Michael Kiernan, Esq., was present, but the appearance of Petitioner Patricia Rae Avery, n/k/a Patricia Rae Self, was waived. Respondent Stephen Anthony Avery and his counsel, Linda K. Rockwell, Esq. were present and the Guardian ad Litem, John J. Romero, Jr., Esq. was present.

The Court having considered the report of the Guardian ad Litem and the representations of Counsel for the parties, FINDS:

1. The recommendations contained in the Guardian ad Litem Report filed herein on December 19, 2002 should be adopted as the Order of the Court;
2. The provider of the psychiatric, neuropsychiatric or psychological evaluation recommended by the Guardian ad Litem should be selected by Gayle

Zieman, Ph.D. from a list of providers who participate in an insurance plan providing coverage for Petitioner Mother;

3. Petitioner Mother should not change life insurance policy beneficiary designations until otherwise ordered by the Court;

4. The parties' three minor children, **Glen Bryan Avery**, age 14, born December 31, 1988, **Jessica Rae Avery**, age 9, born March 26, 1993; and **Montie Stuart Avery**, age 6, born August 8, 1996, have been in the exclusive physical custody and care of the Respondent father since on or about December 4, 2002; and

5. It is in the children's best interests that they and the Petitioner Mother have supervised visits at APN as directed by the Guardian ad Litem.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

A. The recommendations set out in the Guardian ad Litem Report filed herein on December 19, 2002 are adopted as the Order of the Court;

B. Respondent Father shall have temporary sole legal and physical custody of the parties' children;

C. Petitioner Mother shall undergo a psychiatric, neuropsychiatric or psychological evaluation by a mental health professional selected by Gayle Zieman, Ph.D. from a list of providers who participate in Petitioner Mother's insurance plan;


D. Supervised visits between Petitioner Mother and the parties' children shall occur at APN as directed by the Guardian ad Litem;

E. The parties shall each pay their respective set up fees with APN and Petitioner Mother shall pay the costs of supervised visitation at APN;

F. Petitioner Mother shall not change life insurance policy beneficiary designations until specifically authorized by the Court.


