# Albuquerque Man's Arrest Is 8th for DWI

An Albuquerque man has been arrested and charged with his eighth drunken driving offense after an officer spotted him weaving slowly in and out of commuter traffic on Interstate 25.

New Mexico State Police say 51-year-old Ray Lopez Jr. was clocked going 50 mph in a 65-mph zone during the Wednesday afternoon commute in Albuquerque.

Lopez told police he had consumed two beers and taken three tablets of Percocet, a controlled narcotic available by prescription.

The officer also found 15 beers in Lopez's car. Lopez failed field sobriety tests.
